1. Opening and Announcements – Stan Anderson

Stan opened the meeting at 7:30 pm and did introductions. Stan reported that there was a proposal for marijuana dispensary near Washington Elementary School in Point Richmond.

2. Beat Officer's Report – Officer Rogers

Things are relatively quiet. There was one report of a stolen can in Spinnaker Bay. A question was asked about reporting suspect drug dealing. We are to call a SGT Souza at Narcotics if we suspect such activity.

3. Moody Underpass Update – Jacqueline Majors

AT&T is working to move lines. Their work has not resulted in a delay on the schedule as of yet. There are 2 more weekends where they will work all weekend, primarily to work on the railroad. There are 12 new signs to help direct traffic in the Marina Bay area.

4. Security Camera Discussion – Eric Tam, Richmond Police Department

Mr. Tam discussed costs for cameras. The ones they have cost \$1200 and it can cost up to \$10,000 for a camera setup. Cray Cable has some good prices. Comcast also has a good system for a reasonable cost. He identified that expanding into the Marina Bay neighborhood with the City system will take time and money and is not currently a priority. They currently have 50 cameras around the city in key areas.

5. Presentation on Archeology at Moody Underpass – Alex DeGeorgey, Alta Archeological Consulting

Alex gave a nice presentation on the native history of the area and the artifacts and land features in the area. The site was home to the Ohlone Indians. The site is 500 years old and is known as the Stege Mound Site.
