1. Opening and Announcements – Stan Anderson

- Stan opened the meeting at 7:30 pm and did introductions.
- City is considering cuts in Code Enforcement. Stan will submit letter not supporting this such action.
- Issue of LED signs. Most signs are owned by 2 companies. In order to install 1 LED sign they have to remove 10 others.
- The Ferry is progressing and the company has 2 or 3 other sites that are not as attractive as this site for the next location. Stan will send a letter of support on behalf of the council.

2. Beat Officer's Report – Officer Joe Anderson

Marina Bay is an outstanding beat to work. Report of marijuana smoking in open cars, they have a lead on the individual. The park trails are closed from dusk to dawn and they do patrol the trail. PGE has had some problems with copper wire theft. They installed cameras and have since made 3 arrests. Concerns were raised about truck parking on Bayview and Noise from the Rave that was at Craneway Pavillion. He can follow up on the trucks as he sees them. He will pass on the concern with the noise but they had permits for the activity.

3. Moody Underpass Update – Jacqueline Majors

Jetty Drive will be closed 3-4 months. The street lights that are out in front of the Richmond PD will take some time. Wires or something were damaged during some construction and they can't isolate the problem. If they run new lines they need permits to disturb a site where contaminated soil has been capped. She identified that we should visit the project website moodyup.com.
