

Marina Bay Landscape & Lighting Maintenance District

Recent Accomplishments

- **Landscaped the Northwest Corner of Regatta and Marina Bay Parkway**

Cleared weeds, remediated soil, painted the decorative posts bright blue (they will fade and the color will soften and look more like those repainted diagonally across the intersection) and planted shrubs and trees.

- **Added Trellises and Planters to Conceal the Container in "Area T" (across Parkway from Shimada Park)**

The container is used for environmental monitoring of Area T. There are restrictions regarding planting at this location so planters were installed instead.

- **Bus Stop Benches Installed**

Unsightly advertising benches were removed and new, attractive, backless bus-stop benches were purchased by the LLMD and installed. The Advisory Committee to the LLMD authorized black for the Marina Park location bus stop to blend in with the previously purchased new benches (with arms and backs) and authorized green for the Marina Bay Parkway bus stop.

Additional benches are being placed around the District as well.

- **Vincent Park Playground**

The playground surface was redone and the play structures repainted.

- **Winter Storm Damage Addressed**

Trees damaged in the winter storms have been removed and replaced.

- **Vandalism Addressed**

- Graffiti has been removed and vandalized restrooms were repaired. This is an ongoing issue and we encourage everyone to contact the hotline (Contact Code Enforcement at [510] 965-4905) to report graffiti as soon as it's noticed.

- **Bay Trail Benches**

New benches were installed on concrete pads on the Bay Trail at Meeker Slough.
