

Marina Bay Landscape & Lighting Maintenance District Ongoing Projects

- **Pedestrian safety enhancements at Marina Bay Parkway crosswalk**

Concerns regarding pedestrian safety has prompted action to improve the crosswalk. Flashing warning lights will be enhanced. Street striping and signage will be improved.

Hardware has been ordered but there has been a delay in delivery. Current estimate is July 2nd.



- **Trail maintenance**

The system of trails throughout the Marina Bay parks require continual maintenance. There are numerous aspects of this, including weed control and repairs to paved surfaces. Here is a delivery of decomposed granite to be used on trail borders.



- **Landscape maintenance**

After an area has been re-landscaped, it is monitored to ensure planting remains healthy as the planting matures. This includes maintaining irrigation and weeding. It can take several years before the investment in landscaping reveals its full potential. Here we see the flowering of planting done several years ago in the median strip of Marina Bay Parkway



- **Trash pickup, graffiti removal and vandalism repair**

There has been a significant increase in the cost of correcting problems resulting from bad behavior on the part of park users. So far this fiscal year trash pickup, graffiti removal and vandalism repair now accounts for 33% of the time spent by District work crews.
