Recent Accomplishments

- **Bay Trail crosswalk on Marina Bay Parkway**

An important enhancement for Bay Trail pedestrian and cyclist safety is now completed - the crosswalk at Marina Bay Parkway. This caps incremental improvements over the last few years: rerouting the trail to make the crossing more bicycle and pedestrian friendly, repainting the crosswalk to meet current standards and improving signage. The crosswalk has now been enhanced with state-of-the-art button activated flashing lights.

For your own safety, if crossing Marina Bay Parkway please be sure to use the buttons to activate the lights.



- **Stan Anderson memorial bench**

A bench honoring Stan Anderson has been installed on the Bay Trail at the Meeker Creek crossing. Stan was a community leader here in Marina Bay, among other accomplishments a long time president of the Marina Bay Neighborhood Council.

Stan was instrumental in the creation of the Marina Bay Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District.



- **Tennis courts resurfaced**

The district managed tennis courts have been resurfaced. The courts can be found at the intersection of the Bay Trail and Marina Bay Parkway,



- **Tree trimming**

Dead trees have been removed and others trimmed. This is done for safety reasons as well as aesthetic



– falling limbs can cause injury.

- **New planting at Regatta Blvd and Melville Sq**

Diseased trees were removed and replaced with flowering plants. Low planting was chosen to improve visibility for vehicles approaching the intersection.



- **Landscaping at the intersection of Regatta Blvd and Marina Bay Parkway**

This intersection - which serves as the “gateway” to Marina Bay – has been fully landscaped. Weeds were cleared, the soil remediated and decorative posts painted. The area was replanted with shrubs and trees. Additional irrigation was installed.
